

COUNTY OF ORANGE

**PERMITS – FEES – SPECIFICATIONS
FOR
SHORE MOORINGS**

FEES:

The owner of any vessel in Orange County having a shore mooring shall pay to the County of Orange an initial permit fee of sixty cents per lineal foot of overall length of vessel, payable upon issuance of permit, and thereafter shall pay the City of Newport Beach a yearly fee due February first of each year at the rate established by resolution of the agency having responsibility for administration of the specific tidelands.

SPECIFICATIONS:

All mooring weights shall be metal.

A 4 x 4 redwood post, painted white, and with numbers assigned, painted thereon at ALL TIMES, shall be placed against the seawall, and project not more than 12 inches above the sand.

Buoy and post shall have a pulley attached with a line of not less than 3/8 inch diameter at ALL TIMES. Vessel to be moored securely thereto, bow and stern and must not be left on beach.

Mooring buoy shall be metal, or such type as approved by the Director, painted in compliance with State Regulations, with numbers assigned by the Sheriff Harbor Division, painted on at ALL TIMES.

NOTE: Vessels over 18 feet in overall length or any vessel with a fixed keel or fixed underwater propulsion apparatus or gear, must be moored on an off-shore mooring. (County Ordinance, 2-2-67).

NOTE: The Director means the Director of Harbors, Beaches and Parks District. The powers and duties of the Director may be performed by any designated employee or agent.
