A.C.E. classes are held on campus for a familiar learning environment and to make the transition as quick and as safe as possible.

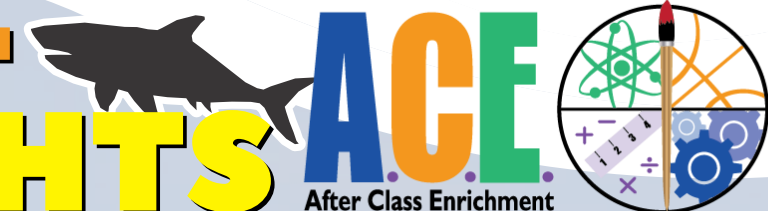
