

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Newport Beach, California, on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, for the following Officers and Measure:

For 4 Members of the City Council (Districts 1, 3, 4 and 6)

Full term of four years

The nomination period for these offices begins on Monday, July 16, 2018 and closes on Friday, August 10, 2018 at 4:30 p.m.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the City are not filed by Friday, August 10, 2018 (the 88th day before the election) the voters shall have until the 83rd day before the election, Wednesday, August 15, 2018, to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on the 88th day before the election, for that incumbent's elective office. This extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by §10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
