NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE NEWPORT BAY TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDLs) FOR COPPER AND NON-TMDL ACTION PLANS FOR OTHER METALS

The Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board has cancelled the Public Hearing for the consideration of the adoption of proposed Basin Plan amendments to incorporate Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for Copper and Non-TMDL Action Plans for Zinc, Mercury, Arsenic, and Chromium in Newport Bay. The Public Hearing was scheduled for October 19, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. at the Orange County Sanitation District, 10844 Ellis Avenue, Fountain Valley, CA

Please note that the Santa Ana Regional Water Board will continue to hold its regularly scheduled Board meeting on October 19, 2018, but as stated above the public hearing for this matter will not be included on the agenda for the meeting.
