For spring 2020, there will be two separate CERT program series held: a Thursday day program and an all-day Saturday program. Participants must register to attend one program but may take classes from the other program if they miss classes during their registered program. Attendance on the first day of class is mandatory to participate in the CERT program.

ARE YOU PREPARED?

The Newport Beach Fire Department invites residents to join the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program to learn how to help their neighborhoods following unexpected disasters. The Cert Program is available free of charge to Newport Beach residents and \$40 for non-residents.

- Put out small fires
- Provide basic medical aid
- Search for and rescue victims safely
- Treat the three killers by opening airways, controlling bleeding and treating for shock
- Organize themselves and spontaneous volunteers to be effective
