- 3. One (1) member with knowledge and experience in transportation analysis and/or circulation planning;
- 4. One (1) member with architectural and/or land use and planning knowledge and experience;
- 5. One (1) member with knowledge and experience in stakeholder outreach for the purpose of engaging individuals and/or organizations within the City in the Housing Element Update process;
- 6. One (1) member with knowledge and experience in real estate financing;
- 7. One (1) member with knowledge and experience with residential development;
- 8. One (1) member with a legal background; and
- 9. One (1) chairperson highly experienced in leading public meetings.

The Committee Chairperson and a Vice Chairperson shall be appointed by the Mayor; and the Committee shall expire and sunset without further action upon completion and submittal of a certifiable Housing Element to the California Department of Housing and Community Development.

Meetings shall be held as required by the business needs of the Committee in such locations, dates and times as allowed by the Ralph M. Brown Act.
