Back of house support space:

Desirable features:

- 1. Good lines of sight to the entire stage area and the screen from every seat
- 2. Lectern that has adjustable height, reading light, clock/timer
- 3. Production booth with high-quality AV equipment (lighting, sound, video)
- 4. Electrical outlets in the walls and floor (lecture hall, reception area, patio)
- 5. Silent, high-quality HVAC system
- 6. Quiet open/close entry doors
- 7. Carpeted hallways to lecture room entry (sound-absorbing)
- 8. Ticket booth with separate Will Call area; well-lit area adjacent for guest check-in
- 9. Wide aisles and space between seats
- 10. Numbered seats; cup holders at all seats
- 11. Green room located backstage, with rest room, mirrors, wet bar; private entrance, accessible from parking lot
- 12. Area adjacent to lecture hall for receptions (indoors, outdoors)
- 13. Outdoor patio area with lighting for nighttime gatherings; built-in sound system, lighting and heaters
- 14. Marquee area outside for banners, electronic signage
- 15. Porte cochere for valet parking
- 16. Easy load-in for trucks and equipment (ramps, high ceilings)
