Subscription databases

Subscription databases

The Library provides cardholders with 39 subscription databases on a variety of topics.
These databases are accessible anywhere, at anytime, through the Library website.
Unlike books, these databases are available to multiple users simultaneously.

Business and Investing

- Hoover's Company Records: proprietary editorial content covering more than 40,000 public and non-public companies.
- Morningstar: insightful information on stocks, mutual funds, variable annuities, closed-end funds and more.
- Standard & Poor's NetAdvantage: provides independent credit ratings, indices, risk evaluation, investment research and data.
- ValueLine: online version of The Value Line Investment Survey.
- Reference USA: provides directory information for U.S. businesses and residents.

Education

Rocket Languages: provides interactive lessons on a variety of foreign languages.

Universal Class: online courses available on a wide variety of topics.

Live Homework Help: an online homework help and tutoring service.

Genealogy

Ancestry Library Edition: Genealogy research database which includes billions of names. (This database can only be used at the library).

Heritage Quest Online: Genealogy research with coverage dating back to the late 1700s..

- Rand California: contains statistical information on a national, state, county and city level from more than 170 databases in the fields of Business, Education, Health and more.
- World Book Encyclopedia: Contains the full-text of the print version of World Book.
- Health & Medical Complete: provides coverage from leading health and medical journals in key medical specialties.
- Literature Resource Center: a literature reference database designed for both the undergraduate and graduate student as well as the sophisticated casual user.
- Biography Resource Center: includes thousands of full-text biographies.

- Current Newspapers (ProQuest): Electronic versions of the Orange County Register, Los Angeles Times, Wall Street Journal, New York Times and more.
- Historical Newspapers: Los Angeles Times and New York Times Historical: Contains electronic versions of the Los Angeles Times and New York Times from the mid 1800s to 2005.
 - ProQuest Magazines and Journal articles: full text articles from numerous magazines and journals.

Children's Resources

- CultureGrams: provides concise cultural and statistical reports on over 200 countries. Reports cover 25 different aspects of the country and culture.
- Kids InfoBits: magazine and newspaper articles in a childfriendly interface.
- Tumble Books: a collection of talking picture books, puzzles, quizzes, and resources for teachers.
- World Book Kids: This version of World Book contains encyclopedia articles, images, games and more specifically developed for elementary school students.

Zinio: free digital magazine subscriptions available on desktop computers, laptops and mobile devices.
