## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

### **CORONA DEL MAR TRANSMISSION MAIN**

#### **Northbound MacArthur Boulevard from East Coast Highway to San Miguel Drive Contract No. 4603**

Dear Resident:

The City has awarded a contract to T.E. Roberts, Inc. for the installation of new water main, the relocation of the existing CM-1 regulating vault, and to perform other incidental items of work in your area.

This important project includes installing a new water main along MacArthur Boulevard from Coast Highway to San Miguel Road. This segment of roadway is heavily traveled and the closure of traffic lanes is required for the safety of the motoring public and to expedite the construction period. Northbound MacArthur Boulevard between Coast Highway and San Miguel Drive (see attached map on the reverse side) will be closed to traffic from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., weekdays, during the following time period:

**Monday, 10/21/2013 to Friday, 11/01/2013**

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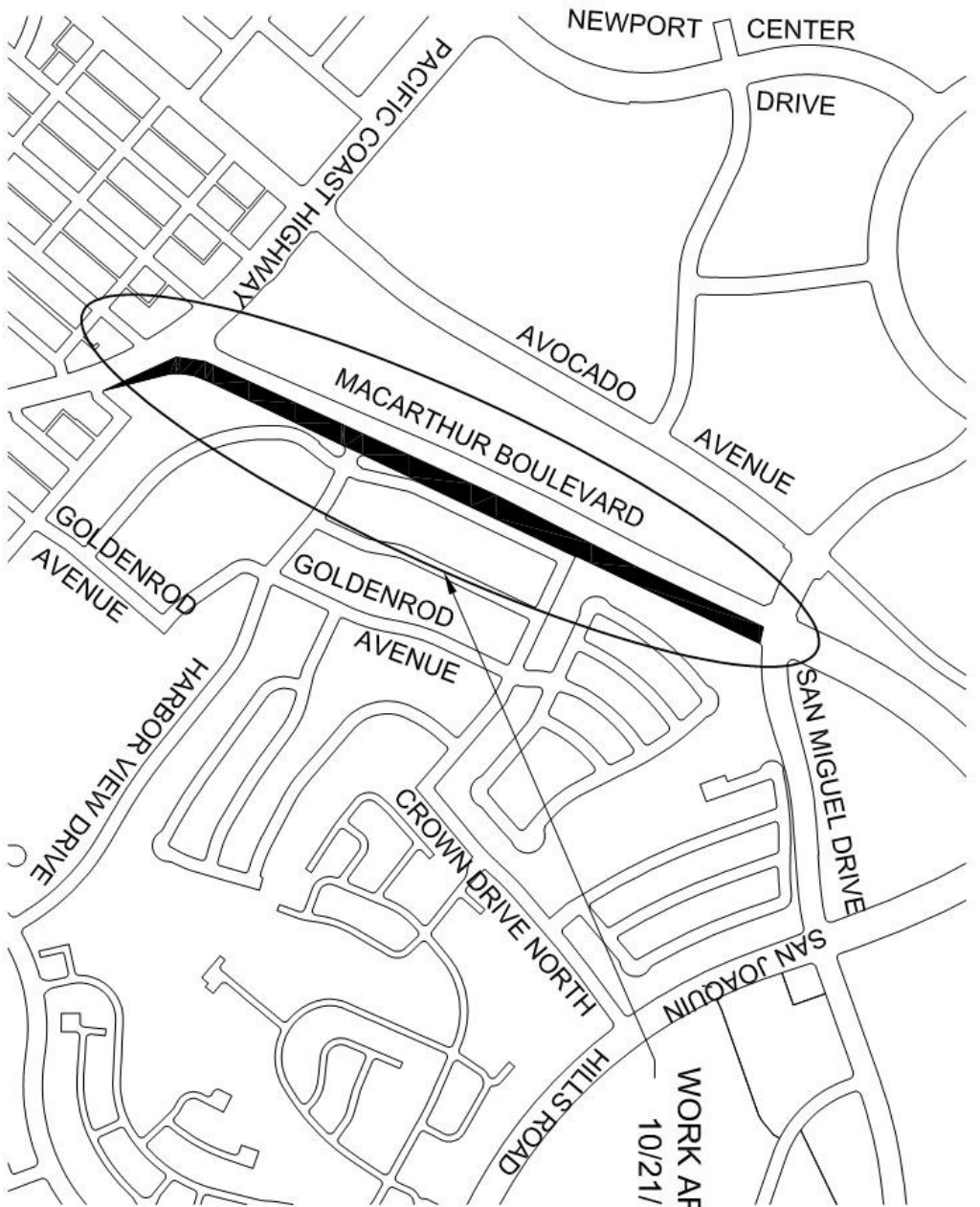
If inclement weather is encountered, the contractor is allowed additional working days to complete the project. Working hours are limited to 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The number one (inside) northbound lane will be open during non-closure hours. The number two lane will remain closed at all times.

One of the challenges with construction along MacArthur Boulevard is the fact that it loses a lane as it passes Harbor View Hills Drive until it widens 600' south of San Miguel Drive. The street closure is required so that heavy equipment and trucks can work in the confined workspace and not endanger commuters traveling up MacArthur Boulevard. The City considered closing the street at night to do this work, but believes the disruption and noise to residents would be greater than closing the street during the day.

We appreciate your patience and ask you to exercise caution when driving, biking and/or walking near the construction zones. Please instruct children to stay clear of all construction activities to avoid the potential for injury. Most importantly, notify us of any problems so that we can respond accordingly.
