

DOVER DRIVE TRUNK SEWER RELIEF

Background

The Orange County Sanitation District (OCSD) is a public agency that provides wastewater collection, treatment and disposal services for approximately 2.5 million people in central and northwest Orange County. We operate two facilities—Reclamation Plant No. 1 in Fountain Valley and Treatment Plant No. 2 in Huntington Beach—and treat an average of 210 million gallons of wastewater each day.

What is this project?

The **Dover Drive Trunk Sewer** runs along Dover Drive from Irvine Avenue to Pacific Coast Highway (PCH). Approximately 7,200 feet of 24-inch diameter sewer line will be installed to replace the existing 15-inch to 18-inch diameter sewer pipeline. In addition, this project also replaces 2,400 feet of a City of Newport Beach waterline.

Why is the project needed?

The current sewer pipeline was constructed in 1952. It is not large enough to handle the projected wastewater flows and needs to be rehabilitated.

Where is the work taking place?

Construction is taking place along **Dover Drive between Irvine Avenue and Pacific Coast Highway** in the cities of Costa Mesa and Newport Beach.



When is the project scheduled?

Construction is scheduled to begin as early as May 2013 and last approximately 15 months. Work will take place Monday through Friday. Hours will vary based on location with occasional Saturday and evening work hours, if required. Notifications will be distributed and posted on our website with specific locations and schedule as the dates approach.

What impacts can be expected?

OCSD is working diligently on this project to ensure every possible measure is taken to minimize public impacts.

There will be lane closures and night work hours for portions of this project to accelerate the construction schedule. Any business and residential areas impacted by the work will be notified in advance.

There will be street closures between Irvine Avenue and Mariners Drive around Mariners Elementary School during the summer months when the children are on summer break.
