



CERT Mutual Aid Program- Orange County, California

CERT Mutual Aid Volunteer requirements:

1. Complete basic jurisdiction CERT program, must be a minimum of 20 hours and be a certified FEMA program
2. Pass jurisdiction background check, graduate, and maintain active status with program
3. Complete ICS 100 and NIMS (or IS 700)- available on-line:
<http://www.training.fema.gov/IS/> or in-person
4. Complete American Red Cross Shelter class: (8 hours)- check www.oc-redcross.org for upcoming classes (can be completed on-line or in-person)
5. Complete CERT Mutual Aid class (6 hours)- within jurisdiction
6. Have active Adult CPR and first aid certification through either the American Red Cross or the American Heart Association

Keep copies of all certifications with ID badges and provide copies to jurisdiction. CMAP Mutual Aid badges are valid for two years from the issue date. CERT Mutual Aid volunteer re-certification is the responsibility and at the discretion of each jurisdiction.
