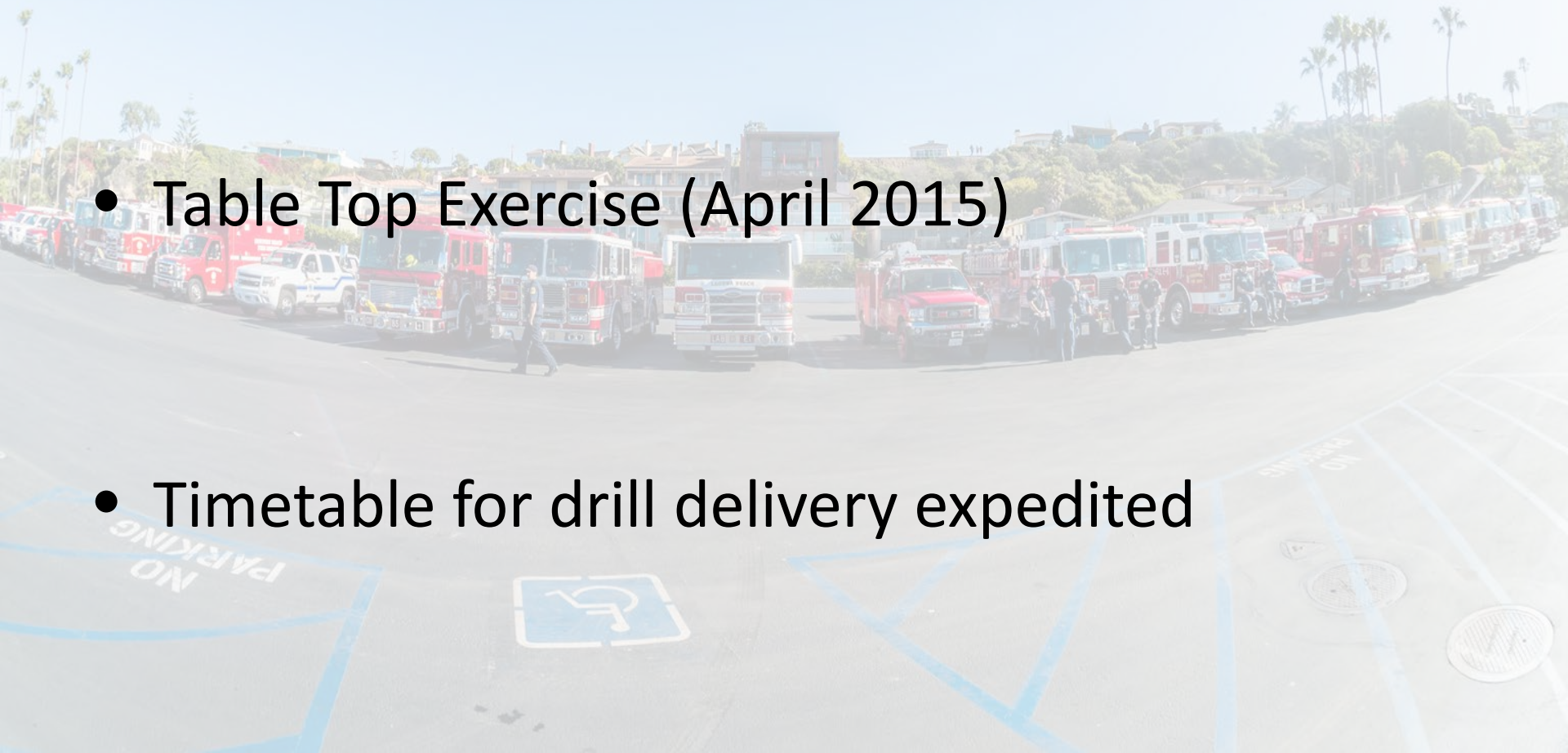

- Table Top Exercise/Full Exercise



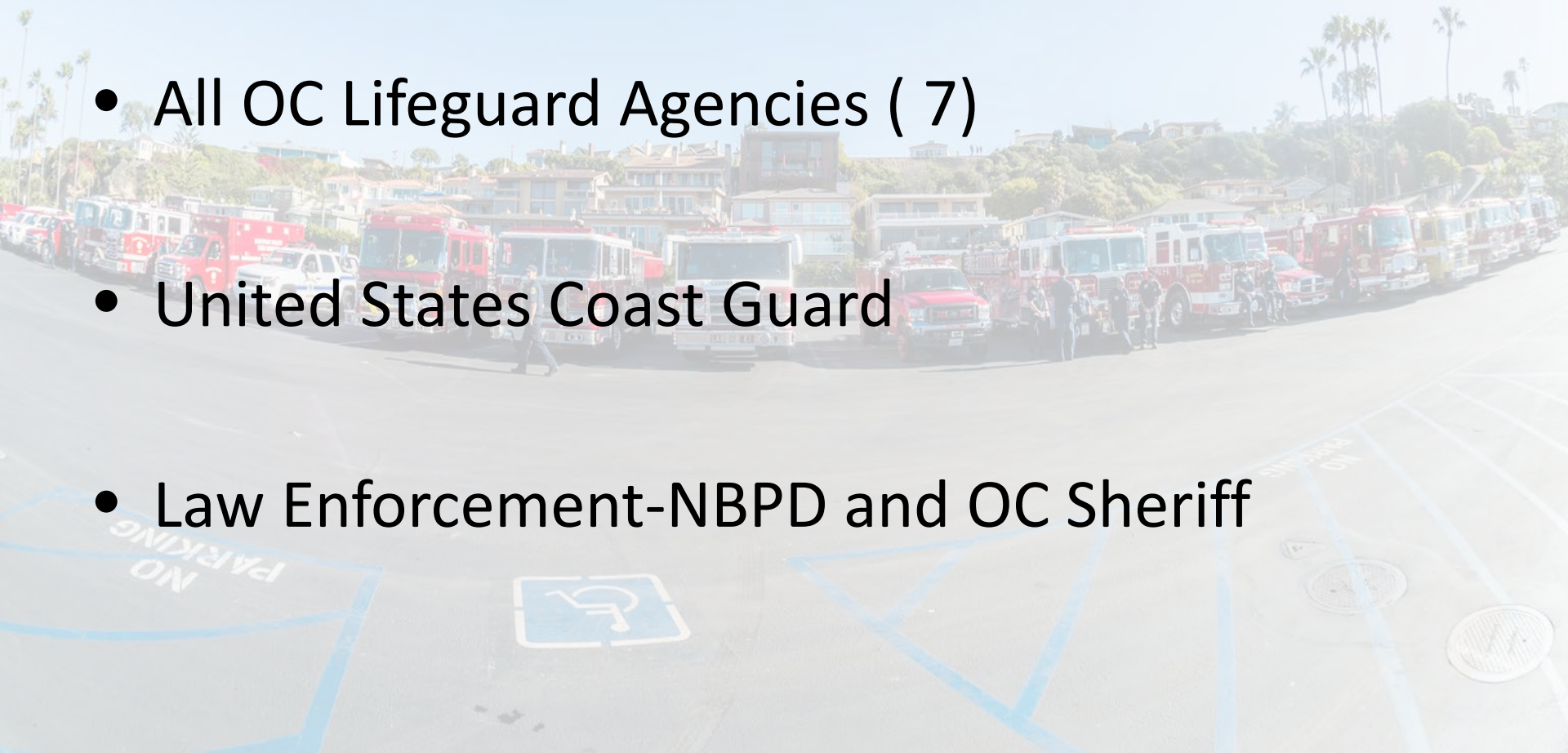
The Beginning

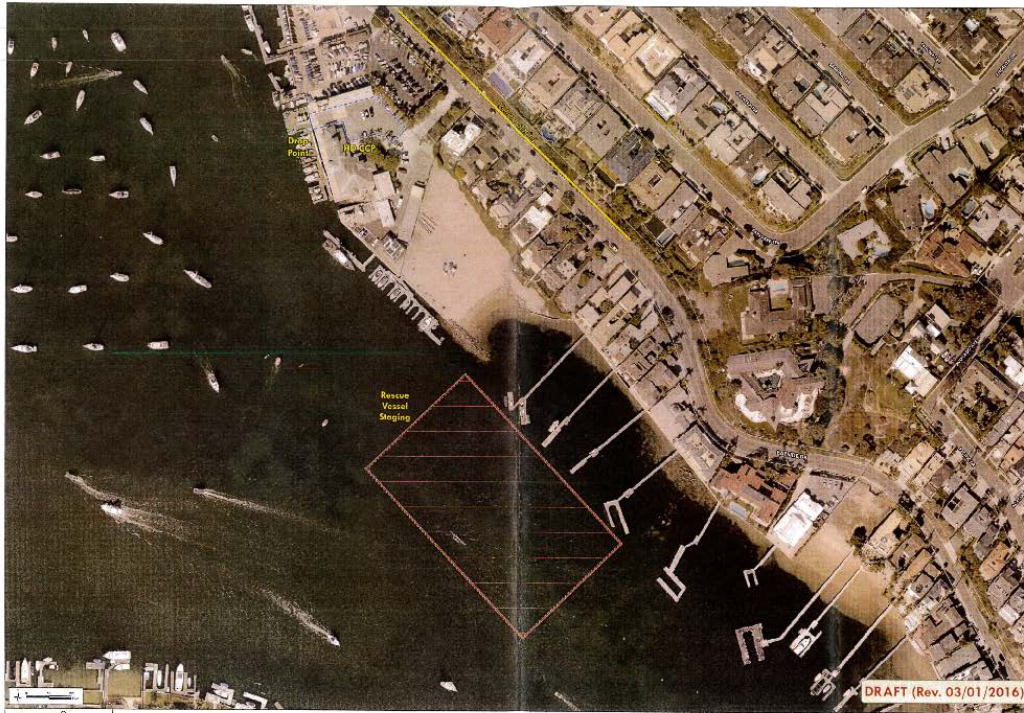

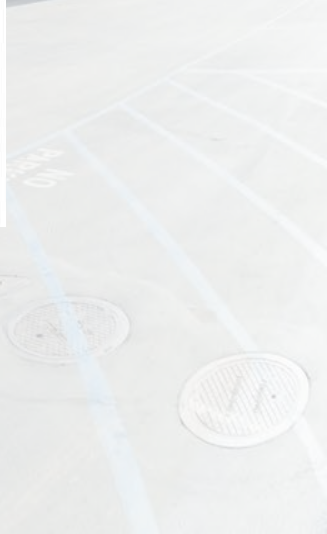

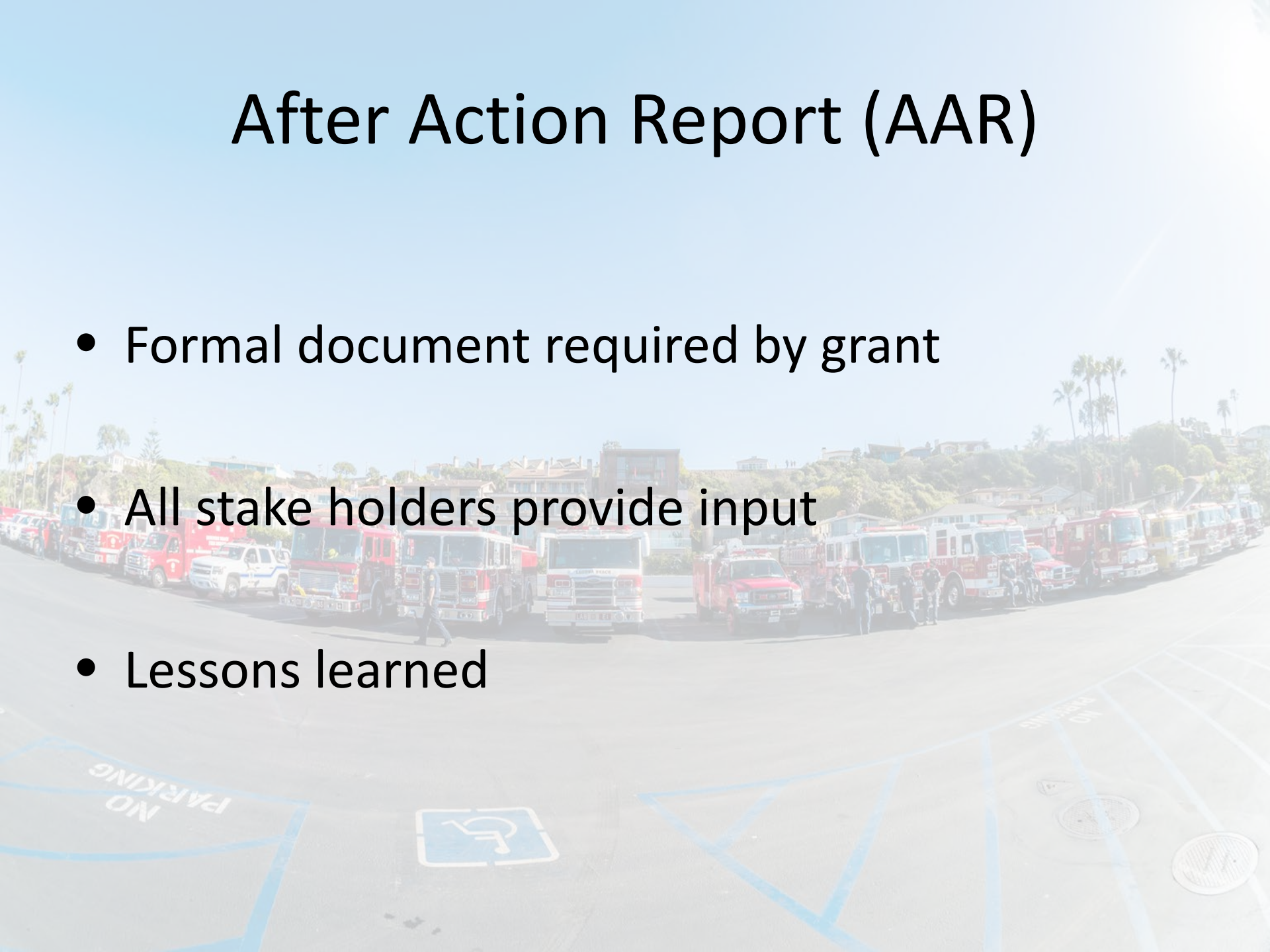
