Underground Water Station Work Necessitates Coast Highway Lane Closure

NEWPORT BEACH, Ca. -- A contractor retained by the City of Newport Beach Utilities Department will be working in a portion of eastbound Pacific Coast Highway at Dover Drive on Wednesday, July 30 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The right turn lane into the Bayshores neighborhood will be closed during this period, but access to the neighborhood will be maintained.

The contractor will excavate an entry hatch to a city-owned, underground water regulating station. The station needs to be accessible in early August when crews work on a nearby project to connect a new 30" water line on Industrial Way. Steel plates will cover the vault until the new water line tie-in is completed. The city plans to wait until after the summer season to remove the steel plates and repair the roadway.
