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Parking Management Study Focuses on Newport Beach Commercial Districts

NEWPORT BEACH, Ca. -- A parking management study is underway in Newport Beach and community participation is an important part of the process.

The City of Newport Beach retained Walker Parking Consultants in April to review and update parking standards and policies, prepare a study of programs that encourage the development of shared use parking facilities, and identify and prioritize areas where parking facilities are needed now or in the near future.

The consultant is studying six of the city's commercial districts: Corona Del Mar, Mariners Mile, Balboa Village, Lido / Cannery / McFadden Square, Balboa Island and West Newport.

A series of public meetings is being conducted in each area studied. The comments and suggestions gathered from business owners and residents will provide the parking consultants with a local perspective on parking issues and help identify goals for parking planning.
