Newport Beach Issues Request for Qualifications for City Hall & Park Project

NEWPORT BEACH, Ca. -- Preparing for its most significant new public building in decades, the City of Newport Beach issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) today for its City Hall and Park Master Plan Design Competition. The RFQ and related documents can viewed by clicking on the City Hall Design and Park Master Plan Project button located in the upper right-hand corner of the city's home page at www.city.newport-beach.ca.us.

The RFQ invites architectural firms to submit qualifications to participate in the design competition for the project's master plan and design work. The submittals will be evaluated and four to five firms will be invited to participate in the competition, which is scheduled to begin in late June. The project includes the City Hall facility, a park, and a joint-use parking facility with the existing Newport Beach Central Library.

Responses to the RFQ are due by Monday, May 19 at 3 p.m. PDT to the City Clerk's Office, 3300 Newport Boulevard, Newport Beach, 92663.
