City Hall & Park Concepts on Display through November 14
Community Comments Welcomed

NEWPORT BEACH, Ca. – To further encourage community participation in the Newport Beach City Hall & Park Project, the five concept plans prepared by the design competition finalists will be exhibited at six City of Newport Beach facilities through November 14. The display boards can be viewed at City Hall, OASIS Senior Center, Newport Coast Community Center, the Central Library and the Mariners and Balboa Branch Libraries. Public comment cards are available and can be submitted at each location.

The plans were first presented during an all-day meeting of the City Hall Design Committee on Saturday, September 27. The meeting was videotaped and edited it into a two-hour program that can be viewed on NBTv (the city's government channel) on Time Warner channel 3 or Cox channel 30/852 and through the city's website (www.city-newport-beach.ca.us).

During the month of October, the Design Committee is holding additional public meetings to rank the five concept plans and ultimately forward one recommended plan to the City Council for discussion and approval. The committee is expected to present its recommendations to the City Council in mid- to late-November. Public comments on the design concepts are welcomed at all meetings.
