




# ROBBERY



SUSPECTS have been ARRESTED  
in **86%** of 2017 robberies



In California, an Estes Robbery is a robbery that occurs when a shoplifter tries to take merchandise from a store and is confronted by store security and the shoplifter attempts to push past the security guard or in any way uses force or fear to avoid arrest.



## SUMMARY

Majority committed by STRANGERS with their HANDS/FISTS/FEET


44% occurred between 2300 to 0259

OVER HALF occurred in AREA 1 and 36% in RD15 alone. 82% of assaults in RD15 were ALCOHOL-RELATED.

ONE-THIRD of all assaults occurred in a BAR OR NIGHTCLUB







Westcliff Dr & Rutland Rd  
16 year old driver with passenger  
41 year old bicyclist (no helmet)  
PCF: Unsafe turn by bicyclist

Fatal Collision #2 – 4/26/2017 1944 hours  
Balboa Blvd & 31<sup>st</sup> St  
77 year old driver with passenger  
66 year old bicyclist (with helmet)  
PCF: Bicyclist failed to stop at stop sign

Fatal Collision #3 – 7/15/2017 0119 hours  
Newport Blvd & Industrial  
25 year old drunk driver – Hit & Run  
41 year old bicyclist (no helmet)  
PCF: DUI driver

Fatal Collision #4 – 7/25/2017 2049 hours  
Pacific View & San Miguel  
50 year old drunk driver (no seatbelt)  
PCF: DUI driver, unsafe speed, collision  
with light pole
