

The Orange County Board of Supervisors will consider the John Wayne Airport General Aviation Improvement Program (GAIP) on Tuesday, May 7. Depending on which project alternative the Board of Supervisors selects, there is a strong potential that the GAIP will generate more corporate and private jet traffic over our community.

The City of Newport Beach supports project Alternative 3 because it would result in the least amount of general aviation jet operations by the year 2026.
