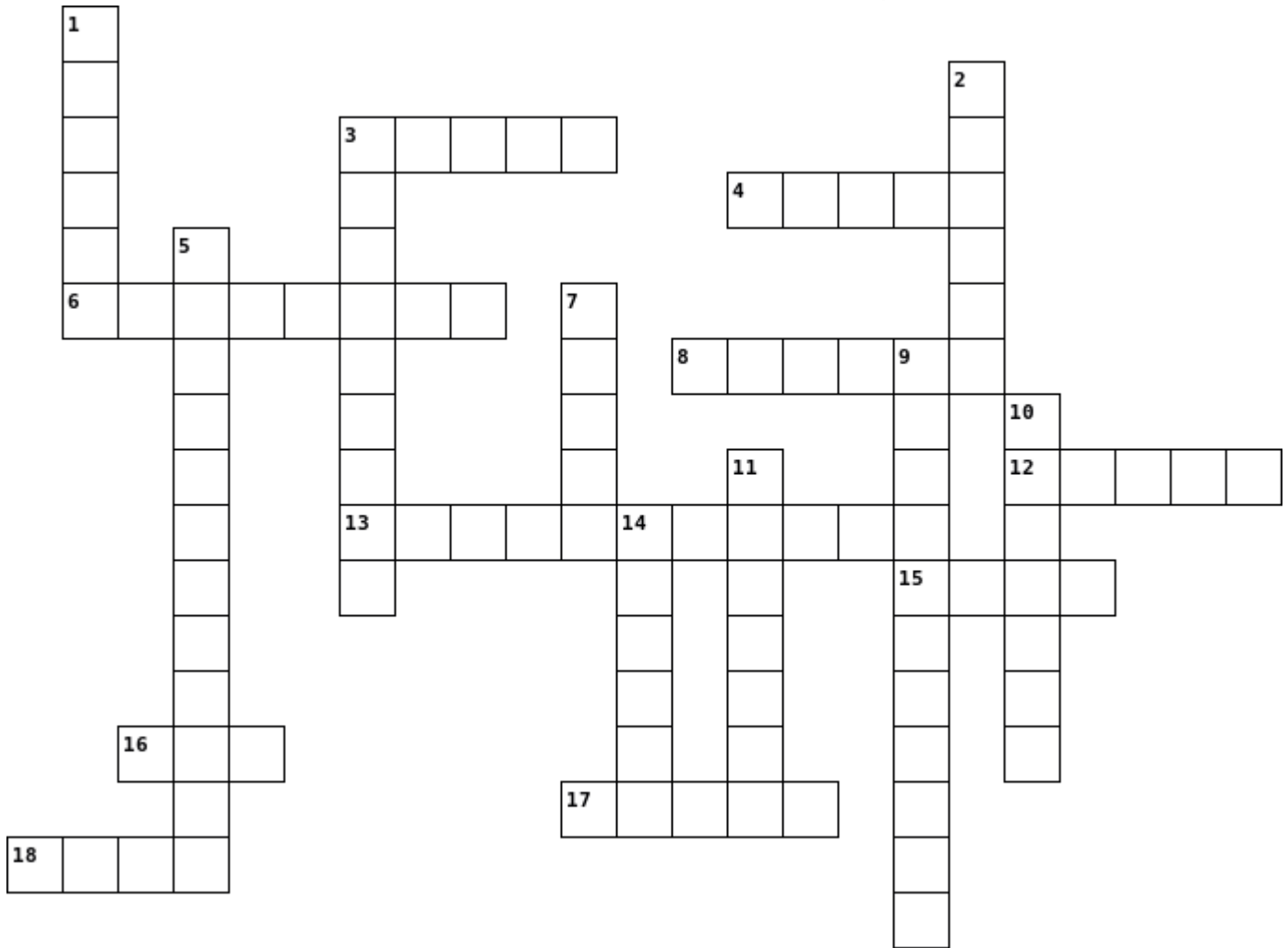

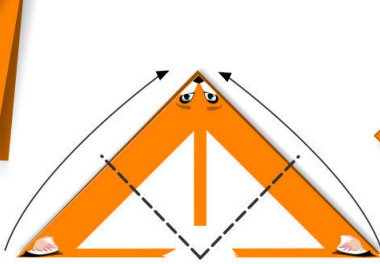
1. The one who eats Kix is Jaiden.

11. Of the person who received the microwave and Jaiden, one always has Corn Flakes for breakfast and the other was born on May 10.



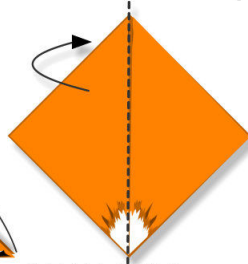

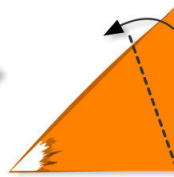
Print, Cut out, and Fold



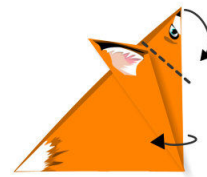
1 Fold in half, then fold the corner points up to the nose.

3 Fold the top ear point over at the angle shown.



4 Open the head flap and fold it down at the angle shown.
