



# OASIS SCAM ALERT



## TEXT MESSAGE SCAM

### How it works:

1. Cyber-criminals text a message claiming you have a delivery that needs payment
2. If you tap on the link, you are taken to a page that asks you to update your search engine app
3. If you tap the *Install Now* button, a malware download begins and you are redirected to a payment screen
4. On this screen, you are asked to pay a fee to deliver your package
5. If you provide any payment information, it is sent directly to the cyber-criminals

### Stay safe tips:

- Only download and update apps through your device's official app store
- Be suspicious of unexpected text messages
- If you are expecting a package, stay up-to-date on your order by visiting the retailer's official website and not by tapping a link in a text message
