The promotional process will include a department evaluation (per Nbfd policy manual) and an assessment, including: obtaining and pumping water through fire apparatus and position, operating a fire apparatus, operating an aerial ladder, troubleshooting and operating equipment carried on fire apparatus, and evaluating road and operational worthiness of fire apparatus. The assessment is tentatively scheduled for June 18, 2025.
