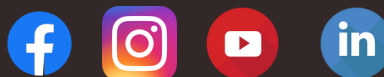

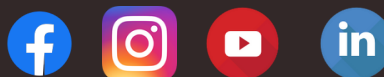

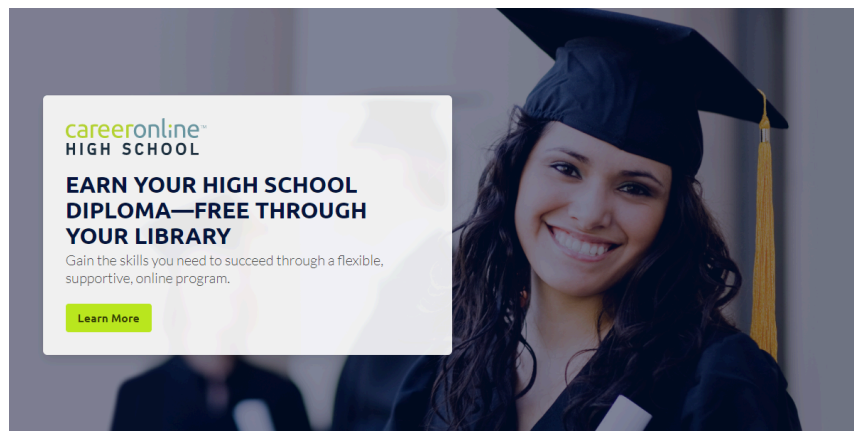

TUTOR CONNECTION RECAP

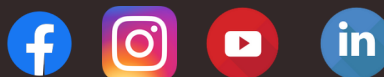
