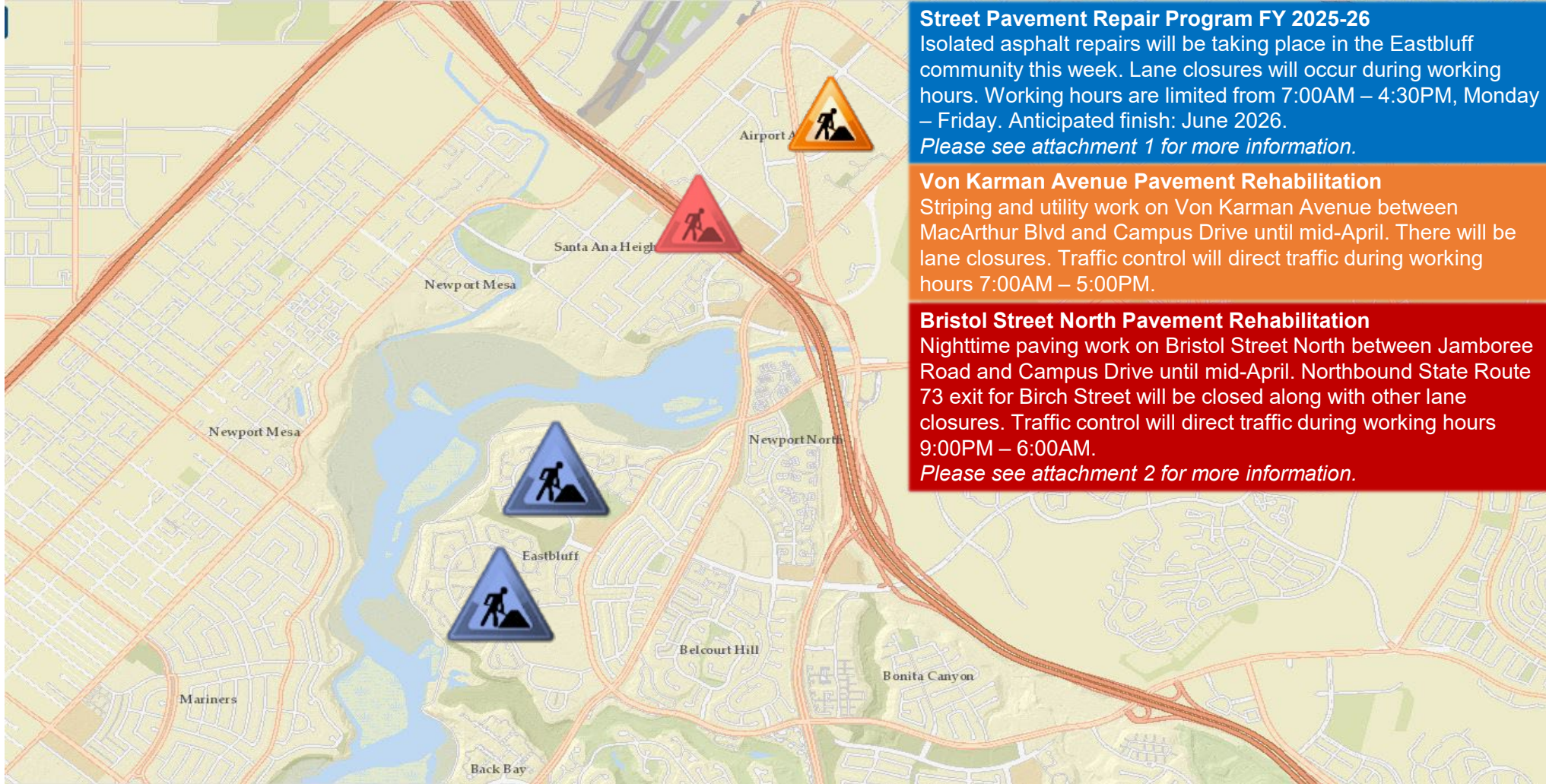

Street Pavement Repair Program FY 2025-26

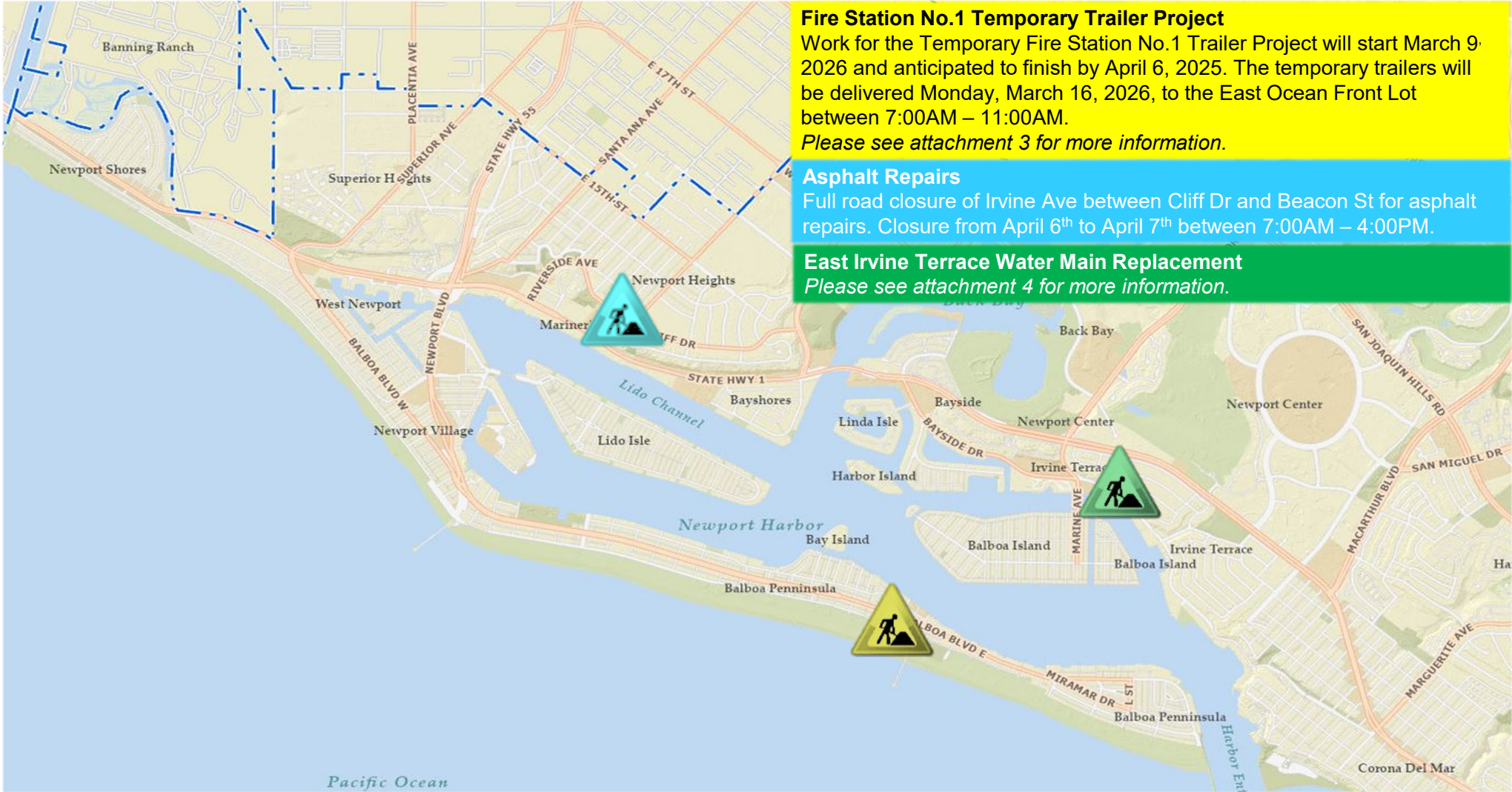

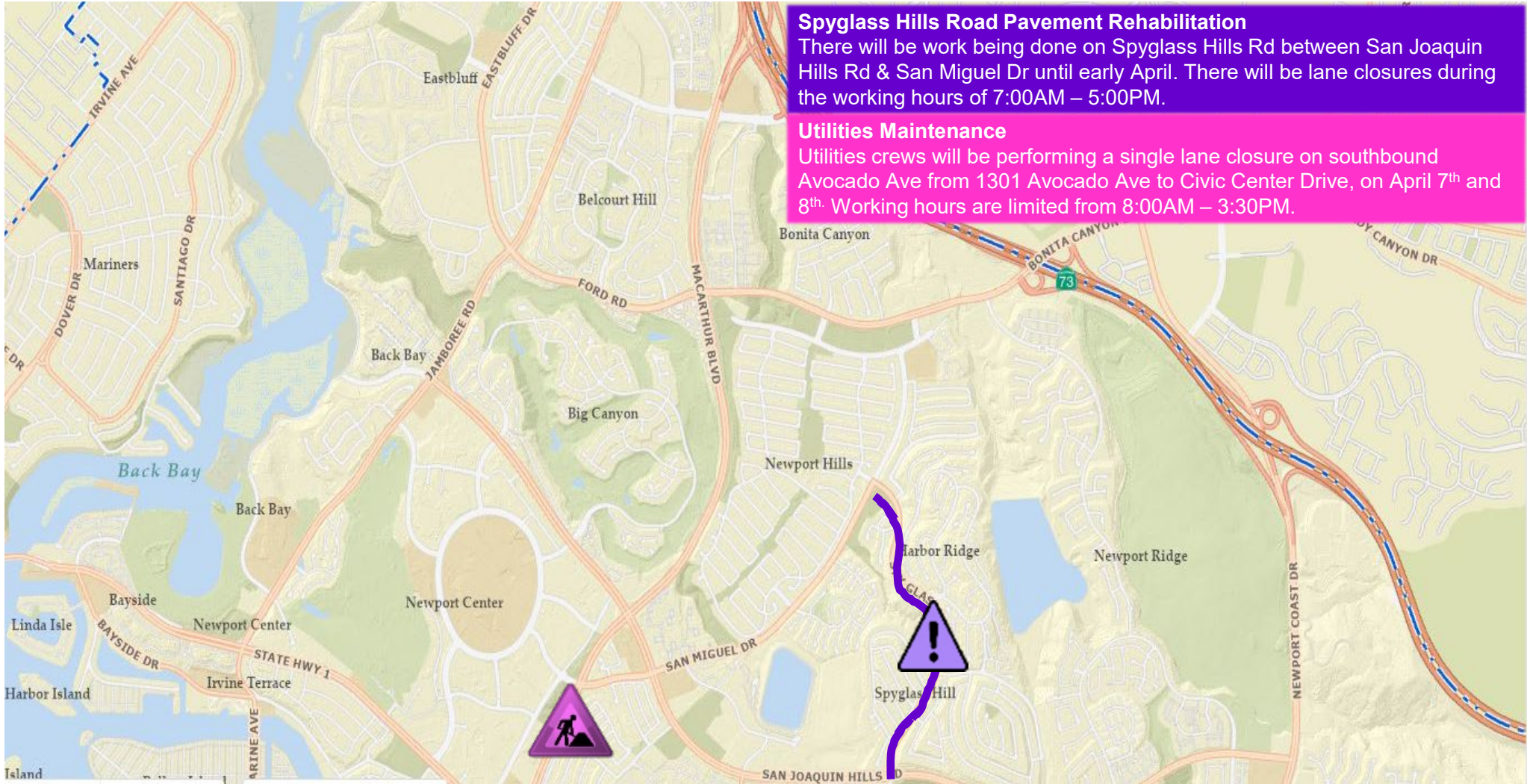

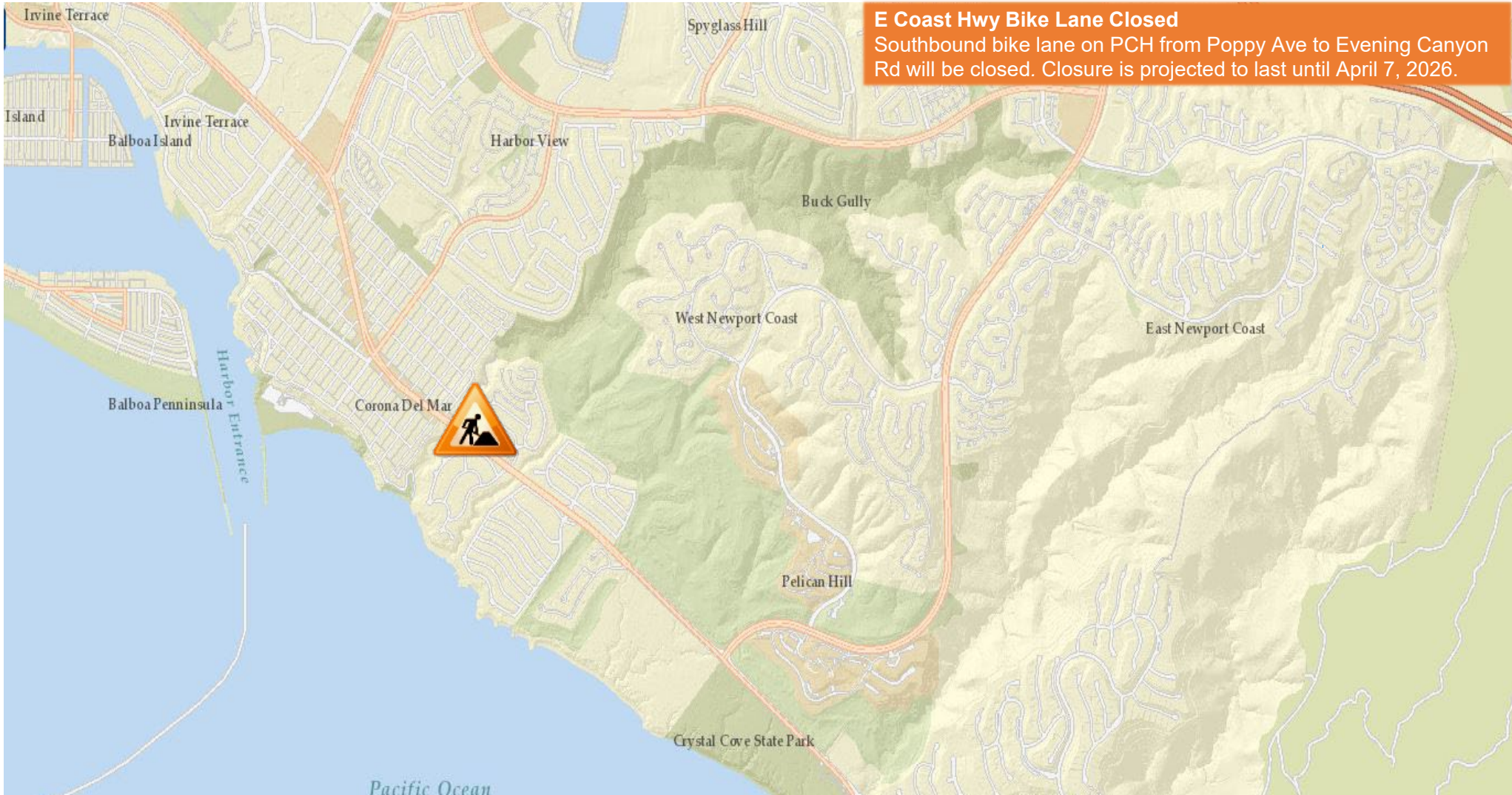

Street Pavement Repair Program
FY 2025-26 (C-9946-1)

Dear Resident:

The City has awarded a construction contract to Onyx Paving Company, Inc. to rehabilitate the asphalt concrete pavement at various isolated locations in the Eastbluff, Newport Mesa, Santa Ana Heights, Bayview, and Airport Area communities. This work is required in preparation for a separate slurry sealing project. Refer to the reverse side for a project location map.

Schedule: Construction will begin on Monday, April 6, 2026. Normal working hours are limited from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. If inclement weather is encountered, the work will be rescheduled to a later date. Work on your street may begin after the construction start date. Please refer to the temporary "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs on your street for precise work dates.

Traffic & Parking: Traffic restrictions at and adjacent to the work locations will be required on days that work is to be performed. Temporary "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs will be posted in advance of any work, warning that vehicles parked within the construction area will be towed away on working days. We request that you observe these restrictions and any other traffic controls in the area. Traffic lane and road closures will be required to complete the work.

Trash & Street Sweeping: Trash collection and street sweeping will continue on its normal schedule.

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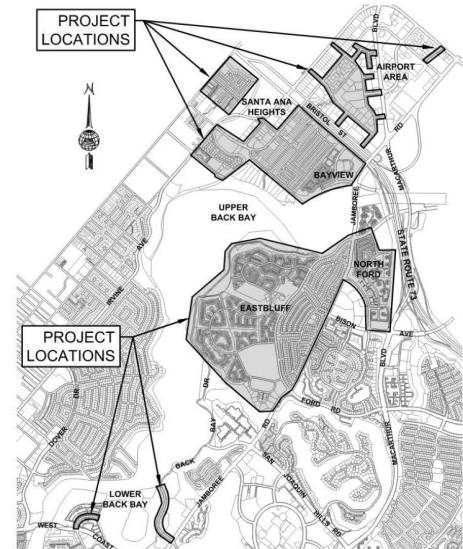

Location Map

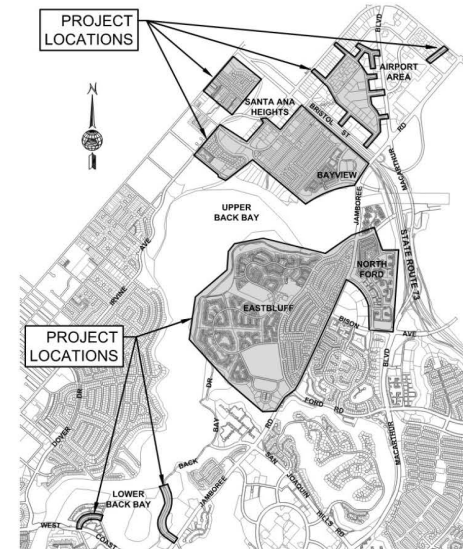

Bristol Street North Pavement Rehabilitation

Dear Residents and Business Owners:

The City has awarded a construction contract to R.J. Noble Company to rehabilitate **Bristol Street North** from Jamboree Rd to Campus Dr.

The proposed improvements include cold milling and overlaying the asphalt pavement, installing traffic signing and striping, and adjusting utilities to grade. Other ancillary work such as striping and utility adjustments will follow immediately after paving.

To minimize public inconveniences, paving operations will occur at night. Nighttime paving will take place from April 6 through April 10. Nighttime working hours are limited from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning.

Traffic restrictions at and adjacent to the work locations will be required on days that work is to be performed. At least one lane along Bristol Street North will be open at all times. The northbound State Route 73 exit at Birch Street will temporarily be closed during construction. Detour signing and/or traffic control will be provided for navigating through or around the construction area.

"No Parking, Tow-Away" signs may be posted warning that vehicles parked within the construction area will be towed away on work days. We kindly ask that you observe and follow any traffic controls or restrictions in the area.

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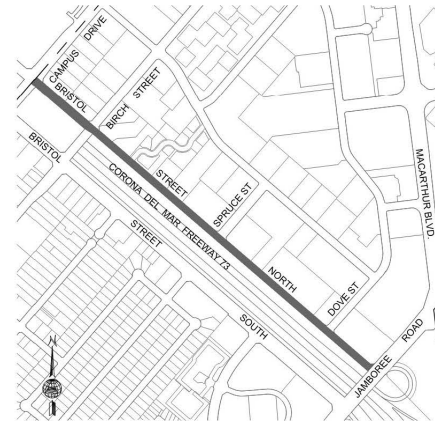

Location Map

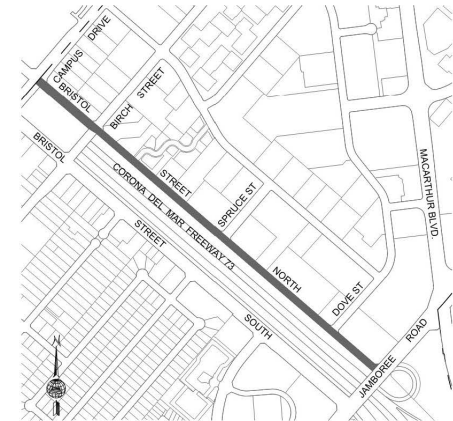

The City of Newport Beach has awarded a contract to Premo Construction, Inc. for the Temporary Fire Station No. 1 Project (C-8865-3). Scope of work includes preparing the site to receive and install temporary trailer, ADA ramp, outdoor safety lights, chain link fencing, gates, and other incidental items of work to make the temporary fire station functional and operable as required by the contract documents.

The contractor will begin construction in March 2026. Please refer to the project locations list on the reverse side. If inclement weather is encountered, the contractor is allowed additional working days to complete the work.

Normal working hours are limited to **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**, Monday through Friday. Should the contractor elect to work outside the normal working hours, with Engineer's approval, the times would be **5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.**, on weekdays and from **8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.** on Saturdays.

Traffic restrictions at and adjacent to the work locations will be required on days that work is to be performed. "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs will be posted warning that vehicles parked within the construction area will be towed away on workdays. We request that you observe these restrictions and any other traffic controls in the area.

Contract No. 9835-1

Dear Resident:

The City's contractor is scheduled to begin construction in the street adjacent to your property. To facilitate construction, the street (as shown on the reverse side) will be closed on the dates noted below:

3/30/2026 to 4/17/2026

The project scope of work calls out for sawcutting street pavement, pavement removal and trenching, construction of new PVC water mains, water valves, water services including water meters and boxes, fire hydrants and other pertinent work that will improve service reliability, water distribution and fire flows.

To shorten the construction duration and minimize the impact to the community, traffic restrictions at and adjacent to the work locations will be required on days that work is to be performed. "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs will be posted warning that vehicles parked within the construction area will be towed away on work days. We request that you observe these restrictions and any other traffic controls in the area. Exercise caution when driving and/or walking through the construction zones. Additionally, heavy equipment and construction materials tend to attract the interest of small children. Please instruct children to stay clear of all construction activities to avoid the potential for injury. Most importantly, notify us of any problems so that we can respond accordingly.

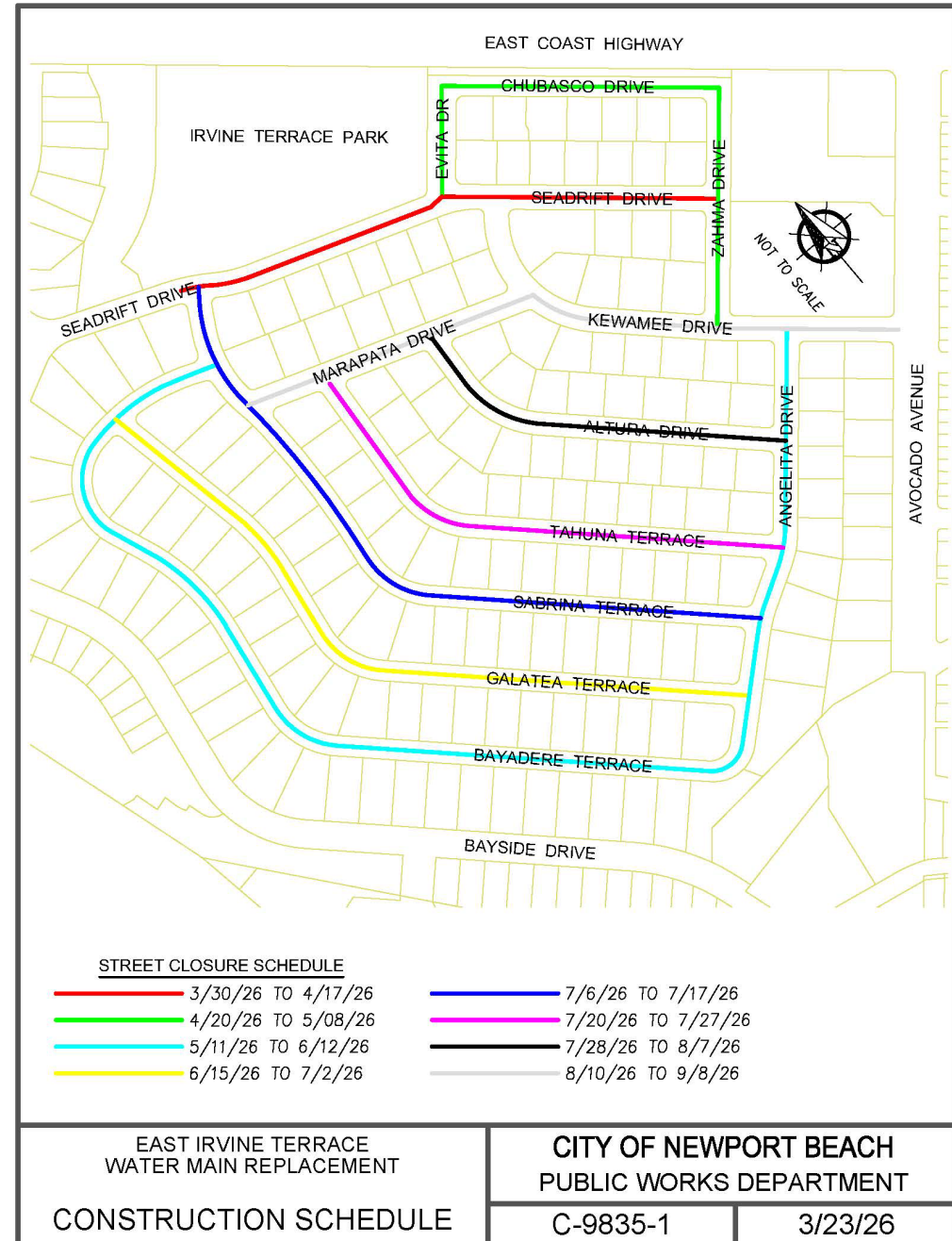

To facilitate this process, we are asking residents to write their address on each trash can. **Trash receptacles must be placed outside in the street no later than 7:00 AM for pick up.**

If inclement weather is encountered the contractor is allowed additional working days to complete the project.

Normal working hours are limited to 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.
