



Flood Zones Map by Stream Source

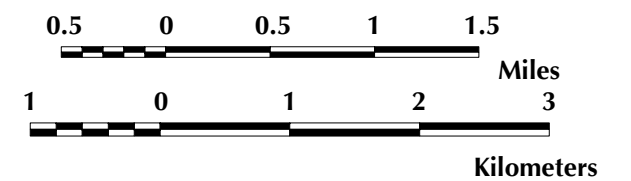
San Diego Creek
