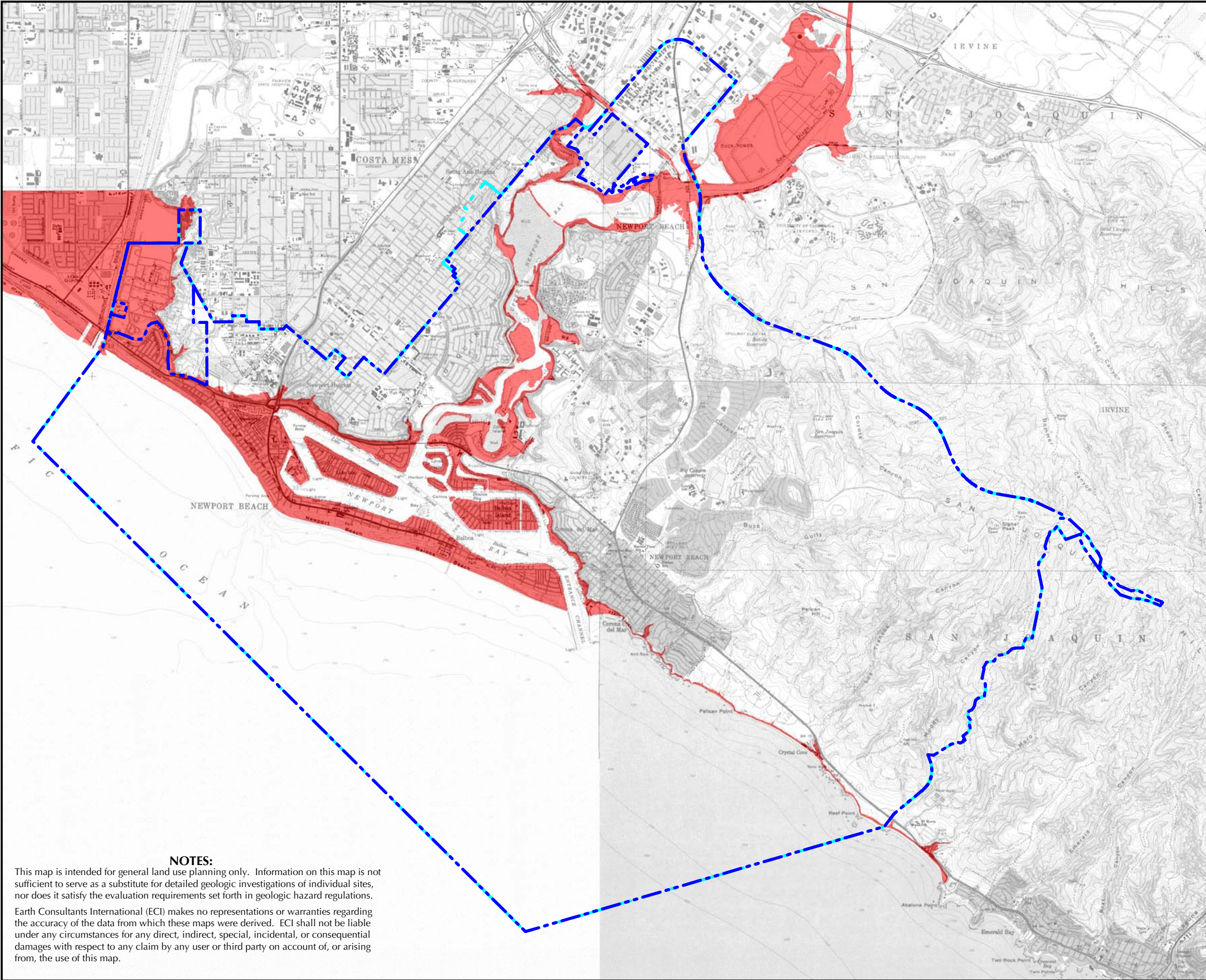




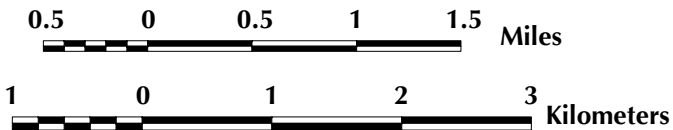
Potential Tsunami Runup Inundation Caused by a Submarine Landslide
