

**City of Newport Beach Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)
Inviting Applications for the Community Development
Block Grant (CDBG) Program For Fiscal Year 2009-2010**

The Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, provides Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to the City of Newport Beach for projects that promote the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing, suitable living environments, and expanded economic opportunities, particularly for low- and moderate-income persons. The City of Newport Beach anticipates receiving approximately \$370,000 in CDBG funds for fiscal year 2009-2010.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Newport Beach is currently accepting applications for eligible public services. The application may be used by non-profit organizations to request funding or by Newport Beach residents to suggest that the City or other organization undertake a new program. A general description of eligible public services is summarized below.

ELIGIBLE PUBLIC SERVICES: Above all, applications must demonstrate that the service will principally benefit persons of low- and moderate-income (households earning less than 80% of Orange County's median income). Types of eligible services include but are not limited to homeless assistance, employment services, substance abuse recovery, senior services, at-risk youth programs, crime prevention, legal services, and services for the disabled.

DEADLINE: All interested service providers must complete an application package, available at www.city.newport-beach.ca.us/EconDev/econ_development.html or the City of Newport Beach, Economic Development Division, 3300 Newport Blvd., Newport Beach.
