

## 6. *Significant Unavoidable Adverse Impacts*

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Chapter 1, *Executive Summary*, contains Table 1-1, which summarizes the impacts, mitigation measures, and levels of significance before and after mitigation. While mitigation measures would reduce the level of impact, the following impacts would remain significant, unavoidable, and adverse after mitigation measures are applied:

### Noise

- **Impact 5.9-5. Significant.** Construction activities at the Hyatt Regency would significantly elevate the daytime and nighttime noise environment in the vicinity of noise-sensitive residential and recreational uses. Mitigation Measures 9-1 through 9-6 would reduce noise levels from construction activities to the extent feasible. However, despite the application of these mitigation measures, nearby noise-sensitive uses would be temporarily exposed to elevated noise levels throughout the duration of construction activities. Consequently, Impact 9.5-5 would be significant and unavoidable and a Statement of Overriding Consideration would be required.



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
